Founded in the mid-nineteenth century, the Stourbridge School of Art sought to train designers for local industries, especially iron and glass. Over more than five decades, the school enrolled many persons whose names are now well known among glass collectors in the UK and in America.

Retired university professor James Measell and his wife Brenda are frequent visitors to the UK to do research and attend glass fairs. James is a trustee of the *White House Cone museum of glass* and has contributed articles to *Glass Matters* and other publications of The Glass Society. This lecture is based upon his PhD thesis completed at the University of Birmingham in 2016.
